

Some of the skills we teach related to Expressive Arts and Design




Range 1: Holds items to look at and feel



Range 1: Experiments with a range of media, through multi sensor exploration



Range 1: Responds to being sung to through gaze, stillness, movement, gesture, facial expression



Range 1: Responds to and engages with the world that surrounds them



Range 2: Experiments with a range of media, tools, materials, sound and whole body movement



Range 2: Holds item and bangs onto a surface



Range 2: Watches items fall and looks for hidden objects



Range 2: Copies movement or gesture



Range 3: Moves while singing vocalising, whilst listening to sounds and music, while playing with sound makers




Range 3: Mirrors and improvises actions they have observed



Range 3: Expresses themselves through physical actions and sounds



Range 3: Pretends that one object represents another, especially when they have characteristics in common



Range 4: Joins in singing songs
