


# Some of the skills we teach related to Tooth Brushing



Range 1: Anticipate care routines with interest and establish good habits



Range 1: Opens mouth for tooth brush



Range 1: Reaches out for, touches and begins to hold objects



Range 1: Explores objects with mouth, often picking up an object and holding it to the mouth for lips and tongue to explore



Range 2: Move towards independence holding a tooth brush and bringing it to their mouth



Range 2: Anticipate care routines with interest and establish good habits



Range 2: Is developing the ability to follow others' body language, including pointing and gesture



Range 2: Cooperates with caregiving experiences



Range 3: Participates in action songs and games, imitating movements and anticipating actions



Range 3: Helps with care routines



Range 3: Anticipate care routines with interest and establish good habits



Range 3: Enjoys playing alone and alongside others and is also interested in being together and playing with other children




Range 4: Develops some independence in self-care



Range 4: Shows an awareness of routines such as handwashing or teeth cleaning



Range 4: May be beginning to show preference for dominant hand
